The floor needs sanding and varnishing again this year, which is the perfect excuse to organize more fundraising events in 2026 to bring our lovely community together.

The loft insulation was upgraded on the same day as the AGM. The additional new insulation now meets the recommended at least 270mm depth over the whole loft except the storage area. That area was already mainly fitted with insulated flooring. Additional vents were provided in seams between the roofing felt to improve ventilation.

We removed some of the boarded area and reused the boards to create additional shelving storage for light objects in the rafters adjacent to the existing storage area. The additional insulation will not only improve our carbon footprint, it should also make

the older part of the hall faster to heat up and keep cooler in the height of summer. The £ 3,500 grant will also enable us to upgrade to LED lights in the old part of the Hall.



From workshops and talks to green fairs, exhibitions, repair cafés, family activities, nature walks, and more - this is our chance to come together and highlight the fantastic work already happening across the district.
